ORDER

WHEREAS, the **Bye Election to 26-Uluberia Parliamentary Constituency** in the District of Howrah has been declared vide Notification No 100/ECI/LET/TERR/ES-II/WB-HP/1/2017 dtd. 03.01.2018 by the Election Commission of India.

AND

WHEREAS, there is apprehension of breach of peace, disturbance of public tranquility due to carrying / movement of Fire Arms resulting in Law & Order problems during the election process.

AND

WHEREAS, as per Election Commission of India in order to conduct the **Bye Election to 26-Uluberia Parliamentary Constituency** in the district Howrah peacefully, carrying /movement of all Fire Arms shall be prohibited.

AND

WHEREAS, in order to conduct the **Bye Election to 26-Uluberia Parliamentary Constituency** peacefully in the district Howrah, it is expedient to impose restriction on carrying /movement of all Fire Arms.

I, SMT.CHAITALI CHAKRABARTI, W.B.C.S. (EXE.) District Magistrate, Howrah in exercise of power conferred upon me u/s 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code 1973 , do hereby prohibit carrying / movement of all Fire Arms within the entire district of Howrah till the completion of election process.
